MSD vs. Kansas

MSD Junior quarterback J. Allen had six touchdowns in the Eagles' 52-20 homecoming win over the Kansas School for the Deaf Jackrabbits on Saturday.

Allen carried 16 times for 240 yards and was 7-of-19 passing for 39 yards and a 15-yard scoring throw to Sophomore running back S. Scott. Senior wide receiver J. Porter also added a 20-yard touchdown run. S. Scott returned an interception for a touchdown from his linebacker spot, recovered two fumbles and posted eight tackles. J. Allen led MSD with 11 tackles while J. Porter matched S. Scott's eight stops.

Sophomore linebacker M. Smith had eight tackles, two sacks and recovered a fumble, while Sophomore defensive lineman S. Percy had six tackles and two sacks. Sophomore defensive lineman T. Owens and Junior defensive lineman N. Garcia had five and four tackles. MSD will travel to play Wisconsin School for the Deaf on Thursday, September 25.

MSD vs. Wisconsin

The MSD Eagles fell to the Wisconsin School for the Deaf Firebirds by the score of 72-36. Leading the offense for the Eagles was Junior quarterback J. Allen. He completed 9 out of 18 passes for 89 yards; carried the ball 16 times for 178 yards including 3 touch down runs, two 2 point conversions and threw 3 interceptions. Sophomore S. Scott carried the ball 5 times for 66 yards, 1 fumble recovery which he ran for a touchdown and received a pass from Allen for a touchdown and had a 2 point conversion. Senior J. Porter carried the ball 4 times for 23 yards.

Defensively, Allen led the way with 9 solo tackles; followed by Scott with 4 solo tackles and 4 assists. Sophomore S. Percy had 4 solo tackles and 1 assist, Junior T. Owens added 4 solo tackles while Sophomore M. Smith had 3 solo tackles and 1 assist. Junior N. Garcia contributed 2 solo tackles and 1 assist, Porter added 3 assists and Sophomore L. Smith had 1 solo tackle.

The 1-3 Eagles will take on the Trojans of Minnesota State Academy for the Deaf on Saturday, October 4 at 7 p.m.
